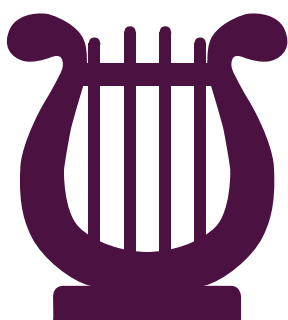
Benefits
