Our Purpose

The Health Professions Living Learning Community (HPLLC) houses male and female first-year students who are interested in the University of Arkansas Liebolt Premedical Program and plan on applying to medical school. Students in the HPLLC will live in the same residence hall and will be enrolled in the same section of University Perspectives (UNIV 1001), a first-year experience class that all freshman take. This class will be taught by Dr. Jeanne McLachlin, a faculty member in the Department of Biological Sciences and Associate Director of the Premedical program.

In-class learning will be supplemented with a few structured academic or social co-curricular activities per semester. Students in the HPLLC are likely to get together often for studying, reviewing, and discussing course work in the residence hall. While the HPLLC is open to any freshman student interested in the health professions listed above, those who plan to participate in Greek Life may find it difficult to manage the time commitments of both programs and so are encouraged to choose one or the other.

Benefits

Benefits of participating in the HPLLC include:

Getting to know faculty and staff in a small setting.

Creating connections right away with peers who share the same major or required classes for the health profession they are pursuing.

Becoming involved at the University of Arkansas.

Required Classes

Students in the Health Professions Living Learning Community will take the following course together:

UNIV 1001 University Perspectives

Students must be ready to begin with University Chemistry I (CHEM 1103) which has a prerequisite of College Algebra, so either credit for College Algebra or an ACT score high enough to go directly into Plane Trigonometry (MATH ACT = 24 or >) or Calculus I (Math ACT = 30 or >).

While the HPLLC is open to any freshman premedical student, those who are enrolled as an honors student or planning on pledging a sorority or fraternity in their first semester, may not have a schedule that is conducive to participation in the Health Professions LLC.
